

Colt Overview:

Yes it's an automatic Mitsubishi Colt....and yes it has a verified 36,103km on the clock!

This very rare and unique machine was a common sight on Aussie roads in the 80s and 90's, but have since been replaced by a fleet of disposable FWD machines. The Colt was one of the original FWD alternatives to the many RWD full size cars, and quickly garnered a reputation based around affordability, economy and quirky styling.

This true survivor has spent its entire life in the careful ownership of a distinguished gentleman of Adelaide, South Australia. A solo owner who loved, cared and maintained his machine (not that 36,000km has needed much maintenance!). This is a time capsule, that showcases a bygone era where FWD cars were tougher, stronger and made of steel.

Under the bonnet is a perky Saturn 1.6L 4-cylinder mated to a silky smooth 3-speed auto. It's all original and all running perfectly. The air conditioner works a treat, and that rear window louvre keeps the harsh Aussie sun at bay – protecting that mint factory cloth trim.

The current owner Geof is astounded at how perfect the Colt is in condition and to drive. "It's hard to fault, and that AC blows icy cold. This is a car suited to a collector or someone wanting a totally unique and different machine. I can guarantee it will be the ONLY ONE at the coffee and cars event that's for sure!"

Very minor restoration is required, with the vehicle currently in a complete, good running state.
